Visec fully supports the Vista USB grabber.

The problem is the manufacturer included another drive that that uses a BDA architecture instead of WDM


You can easily get the grabber working in Vista by doing the following


1) Go to Windows Vista Device Manager Start – Control Panel -> Device manager
